Fine Motor Developmental Milestones





- ☐ Hands are in a fisted position & arms movements are random
 ☐ Watches movement of their hands & other moving targets (mobile/person)
- \square Swings at targets using their whole arm
- ☐ Begins to hold objects in their hands
- ☐ Brings their hands together
- \square Begins to move objects from one hand to the other
- ☐ Begins to hold & shake toys using both hands





- ☐ Begins to grasp things by "raking" with their hand
- ☐ Uses their pointer finger to touch things
- ☐ Holds & drinks from bottle on their own
- ☐ Claps hands
- \square Feeds themselves finger foods
- ☐ Turns pages in a book a few pages at a time
- ☐ Pincer grasp begins to develop (using index finger & thumb)
- ☐ Uses a fisted grasp to scribble
- ☐ Holds two small objects in one hand
- ☐ Begins to show a preference for one hand over the other (beginning development of right vs. left handed)





- ☐ Builds block towers (2 blocks)
- ☐ Waves hello & goodbye
- ☐ Scoops objects with a spoon or small shovel
- ☐ Bangs objects together using both hands
- ☐ Scribbles with crayons on paper
- ☐ Places small objects in a cup or container
- □ Puts rings on pegs
- □ Holds crayon with pincer grasp to scribble
- ☐ Builds block towers tower (3-4 blocks)
- □ Opens loosely wrapped packages or containers
- □ Turns pages in a book one page at a time



- **□** Turns doorknobs
- ☐ Strings large beads
- ☐ Zips & unzips large zippers
- ☐ Uses a spoon & fork correctly
- ☐ Manipulates clay or play dough
- ☐ Screws lids on containers on & off
- ☐ Uses pincer grasp to pick up small objects
- ☐ Make snips on paper with child-safe scissors
- ☐ Washes hands independently
